National Workshop held



A two day national workshop on "PAiSA, RPL, Apprenticeship and MIS" was inaugurated by Shri Sanjay Kumar, Joint Secretary & Mission Director (NULM), MoHUA from January 17-18, 2019 at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi. The workshop deliberated on Recognisation of Prior Learning module, Apprenticeship, operational problems being faced by states using Skill India Portal, SDIS and SDMS 0.1. A session on Street Vendors was also conducted where draft street vendor compliance index report was presented by Centre for Civil Society. Mission Directors, State Mission Managers handling EST&P & MIS of 32 States/UTs participated in the workshop.



From the States

Progress So far



Bihar: On January 24, 2019 Shri Suresh Kumar Sharma, Hon'ble Minister (UD&HD) inaugurated newly a constructed shelter for urban homeless at Bhagalpur. This 50 bedded shelter is equipped with food, drinking water, toilets and other facilities.

Maharashtra: On January 15, 2019 a job fair was organized in Navi Mumbai under the Shehri Samridhi Utsav. Around 3,000 candidates were interviewed by companies/firms for job opportunities in sales, marketing, ITES, accounting, finance etc. 1,489 candidates got placement offers during this event.

Uttar Pradesh: Three newly constructed shelters capacity of 100 persons each was made functional in Bareilly, Firozabad & Shikohabad. These shelters are equipped with purified drinking water, blankets, toilets and other essential facilities.

Odisha: The Municipal Corporation, Berhampur undertook initiative to empower the women of the region by conducting a training programme on women mason. 10 members of Mahamayee Self Help Group, undergone training on construction of toilet from January 1-31, 2019. The ULB has decided to engage SHG women in the construction of community toilet for SBM and houses for PMAY, to bring improvement in their livelihoods.

Pradesh Andhra Shri Hon'ble Deputy Chinarajappa, Chief Minister inaugurated a Call Centre under MEPMA in Kakinada for post-placement tracking of the trained candidates. During the occasion website a www.saukaryam.in, developed by Malireddi Charitable Trust, was also launched as a pilot project. The website would become a platform for job seekers.

Chandigarh: 30 entrepreneurs participated in Entrepreneurship Development Programme (EDP) training from January 25-28, 2019 organised by Municipal Corporation of Chandigarh in association with Centre Regional Entrepreneurship Development (RCED). The participants were trained in accounts, book keeping, skill, customer dealing, marketing and bank liasoning during the training.
