These 29 interns, representing diverse academic backgrounds, will learn various aspects of urban livelihoods and work directly with the State and City Mission Management Units of DAY-NULM, Kerala. The interns will delve into crucial studies covering three significant areas, which include assessing the impact of the Mission on the urban poor, identifying business opportunities in production/service and trading sectors, and evaluating the Urban Poverty Reduction Plan (UPRP) prepared by SHG women.
